## Livestock Show Exhibitor Checklist

Enter Gate 7  Upon arrival at the Tulsa State Fair, all animals are required to enter through Gate 7. Gate 7 is located off of 15th Street between Yale and Harvard Avenue. Gate 7 is open from 6:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m. No animals will be allowed to enter the grounds during the hours Gate 7 is closed.
Health Inspector All animals entering the grounds must be accompanied with an official health certificate issued within 30 days of your arrival and any other required information for your specie as outlined in the Animal Health Regulations. Please have your health papers and other required information ready to show to the health inspector.
McDonald's Livestock Exhibitor Welcome Center and Credentials Station  The McDonald's Livestock Exhibitor Welcome Center and Credential Station is located at Gate 7. Please pick up all exhibitor passes, parking passes, and other permits paid for when you submitted your entries. Credentials will be under the name/farm in which you submitted your entries. Additional passes or permits can be purchased at the McDonald's Credential Station or in the Livestock Office located in the Oklahoma Ford Dealers Barn.
Unload at Assigned Barn Proceed to the barn you are assigned to and promptly unload your trailer in the designated stall/pen assigned. Please be respectful of other exhibitors by adhering to the 30 minute unloading time limit.
<b>Trailer Parking</b> After you have unloaded, please proceed to the secure trailer parking lot located at the ONG Lot located off of 15th Street between Yale and Sheridan.
Check In Check in your animals with the superintendent assigned to your show. Read your special rules for specific check in procedures and times.
Releases After the conclusion of your show, releases can be obtained from a superintendent, in the Livestock Office located in the Oklahoma Ford Dealers Barn, or Horse Show Superintendent Office located in the Ford Truck Exhibit Hall.
