- Items of offensive, controversial or objectionable nature or subject matter may not be accepted.
- Fair management holds final decision on judging and displaying of all entries if they are over a certain.
- Exhibits must dry before they will be accepted by the Tulsa State Fair.
- Only artwork and oil paintings must be framed for suitable hanging – no sawtooths.
- All work must have been made within one year of the 2017 fair
- **ENTRIES ARE LIMITED TO ONE PER CLASS. You may enter as many classes as you would like.**
- Artwork and Oil Paintings
  - Need to have a hanging wire on the back of the frame.
  - Cannot exceed 30" x 30", including frame
- Exceptional Division
  - Limited mental capacity or physical disability.
- Glassblowing
  - Beginner – 5 years or less experience
  - Advanced – 6 to 9 years of experience
  - Master – 10 or more years of experience
- Hand-Painted Porcelain
  - No seminar pieces accepted.
  - Novice – 3 years or less experience
  - Advanced – More than 3 years of experience
  - Professional – Open to teachers & those who sell their artwork
- Leather Crafting
  - Any individual having won 5 or more blue ribbons in Leather Crafting at the Tulsa State Fair must enter in the Open Division. A Sweepstakes ribbon counts as two blue ribbons.
  - Individuals may enter the Open Division even if they have not participated at the Novice level.
- Native American Arts & Crafts
  - Items must have been made within the past year.
  - Artifacts may not be entered.
- Rubber Stamping
  - Use rubber stamps, embellishments, ribbons, fibers, brads, charms, eyelets, etc.
  - No stickers.
  - No peel and stick items.

- Scrapbooking
  - Must be 12" x 12" page in protective sleeve. The Tulsa State Fair will be pinning up your pages using protected sleeves.
  - All items including photos must be computer generated for digital scrapbook pages.
  - Canvas must not exceed 30" x 30", any shape allowed.
  - Shadow Boxes or Boxed Scrapbooking not to exceed 30" x 30", any shape allowed.
- Wood Items
  - Entries must be constructed predominately of wood.
