



Livestock Exhibitor Barn Etiquette Policy

2016 Tulsa State Fair Open Show and Junior Show Barn Etiquette

Listed below are the expectations of exhibitors and animals in the barns during the duration of the Tulsa State Fair. Please remember, the barns are a window to the public, educating and promoting the importance of the agriculture industry. It is important all barn rules below are followed.

- Animals clean, well groomed, and properly spaced.
- Adequate bedding for animals.
- Aisles clean & neat with adequate width for visitors.
- Feed, tack, and equipment clean and stored neatly.
- Personnel items (backpacks, food, clothing, bedding, camping items,) neatly stored.
- Camping will only be allowed in the stall areas from 10:00 p.m. – 7:00 a.m.
- Manure properly disposed of in the manure carts outside of barns. **DO NOT** put manure in trash cans. Yellow trash cans are for trash only.
- Trash properly disposed of in the yellow trash cans.
- Attitude of exhibitors must be knowledgeable, courteous and friendly.
- Exhibit courtesy to fellow breeders.
- Barn should look welcoming and appealing to the public at ALL times.
