- Items must have been made between October 2016 and September 2017.
- Soiled articles will not be accepted.
- Articles that have an odor or cigarette smoke will not be accepted.
- Entries will be placed on exhibition at the discretion of the superintendent.
- Hand Weaving
  - Articles must be hand-woven; the fabric formed by an interlacing of warp threads and weft threads. Small amounts of other hand techniques (knitting, crochet) or commercially woven fabric are permissible, as long as the majority of the item and the focal point of the design are hand-woven fabric. The judge will determine if the entries with other techniques fulfill this condition.
  - Piece goods (yardage) must consist of at least two yards of fabric.
  - Open to amateur or professional.
- Handspinning
  - Skeins must be tied in four places.
  - Skeins must be between two and four ounces except for novelty category.
  - Skeins must be completely handspun except for novelty category.
  - “Blends” means a blend of two fibers, such as merino and silk, etc.
- Modern Quilt – A functional quilt inspired by modern design. A quilt that embraces non-traditional piecing, design and/or quilting.
