- Flowers and plants will be given the best care possible, but any not suitable for display will be returned to exhibitor.
- All horticulture, except for flower arrangements, must have been grown by the exhibitor and in his/her possession three months prior to entry. No commercial grower is eligible to enter the competition.
- Exhibitors must conform to specified flower pot size.
- Artificial flowers may not be used in any arrangement with the exception of silk flower arrangements.
- Exhibitors must conform to specified flower pot size.
- Artistic arrangements must not exceed 18” around and 20” in height. To be viewed on all sides.
- Cut flowers, definitions:
 - Blooms – One individual flower with stem and foliage
 - Stem – main axis of a plant
 - Spike – a lengthened flower cluster
 - Spray – a main stem with side branches and several blooms
- Pumpkin Decorating:
 - Weight of pumpkin not to exceed 25 lbs., this rule will be strictly enforced
 - After your decorations, the pumpkin should still look like a pumpkin
 - Do not carve or puncture
 - All pumpkins entered must be real
 - Exhibitor may enter only one pumpkin per class
 - Decisions are the sole responsibility of the Tulsa State Fair judges and are final
