ENTRIES ARE LIMITED TO ONE PER CLASS. You may enter as many classes as you would like.

- Culinary
 - Baked goods must be in disposable containers and covered. Cakes must be baked in 8” or 9” round or square pan. Maximum height of 6” including decorations.
 - Baked goods will not be returned; winners may pick-up their ribbons, Monday, October 9, 2017.
 - Must submit recipes for each entry, typed or written legibly on Official Tulsa State Fair recipe form with name on the back.
 - All baked goods must be made from scratch unless otherwise stated.
 - Children’s Culinary Division is available for ages 9 & under. Use of box mixes are permitted.
 - All canning foods will be judged by appearance and proper canning process.
 - Canning process used and time processed must be included in your recipe.
 - All recipes become property of the Tulsa State Fair. Do not send recipes with entry forms, bring them on take-in day.
- Hanging Art & Pencil
 - Must be framed.
 - Must be equipped with sturdy wire suitable for hanging on pegboard.
 - You **MUST** supply wire and have it firmly attached before items are checked-in.
 - Do **NOT** use yard, thread, string or tape to attach wire.
 - Not to exceed 21” x 24”, this rule will be strictly enforced.
- Lego’s
 - Lego creations must be on an 18” x 18” cardboard or wood base; pieces must be securely attached.
- Photography
 - All photos must be matted.
 - All photos must be 5” x 7” or 8” x 10”
 - No foam board
 - No frame. No hangers on back.
 - No more than one layer of matting.
 - All photos must have name, division and class in the lower right-hand corner.

- Exceptional
 - Limited mental capacity or physical disability.
 - Pictures not to exceed 16” in any direction.
- Pumpkin Decorating
 - Weight of pumpkin not to exceed 25 lbs., this rule will be strictly enforced.
 - After your decorations, pumpkin should still look like a pumpkin.
 - All pumpkins entered must be real.
 - Exhibitor may enter only one pumpkin per class.
 - In the natural/green class (all age groups) decorations must be natural.
 - Paint on pumpkins must be completely dry when arriving at take-in.
 - Pumpkin will be moved around. IT is important that everything is securely fastened to pumpkin.
 - Pumpkins are not to be carved.
